JoAnn Fleming, president of Grassroots America - We the People is coordinating a tour of Protect Your Vote Texas! around the state. Speakers from Direct Action Texas and True Texas Elections are also participating. The next stop is this Saturday, March 16, from 1:00 to 4:00 at the Richardson Civic Center, 411 West Arapaho, Richardson. This is just west of Central Expressway (US75). There is no cost to attend, and reservations are not required. Other stops are scheduled or in the planning stage for McKinney, Houston area, and Hill Country / Austin.

The right to vote in a free & fair election is the most basic civil right! The preservation of the rights of the American people depend on secure elections. We must demand action from legislators!
