Reaching out to Republicans in Flower Mound and the rest of south central Denton County with information about meetings, events, and activities that may interest you; with an emphasis on meetings and activities hosted by Flower Mound Area Republican Club.....

This week I received a fund raising letter from Tom Fitton, president of Judicial Watch. It caught my interest because our speaker next week told some of us earlier this year that Judicial Watch is one of the key organizations fighting corruption and cover-up in our government. I am sure that Tom Fitton would not mind if I paraphrased just a few points of interest in his letter:

- Judicial watch investigations and litigation are uncovering an effort unprecedented in American history to drive a President from office because he represents a threat to the Deep State ("permanent government") and Washington's corrupt, leftist and elitist culture.
- Today's Deep State comprises legions of Clinton and Obama political appointees, Leftist career civil servants, and powerful private contractors who control many layers of our federal government working closely with DC establishment of both political parties - with the aid of liberal media operating as their propaganda arm.
- Fitton believes that Deep State actions constitute a direct challenge to our Republican form of government.
- The rule of law and the US Constitution are under assault by the Deep State because
  it is more insidious than mere partisanship and more dangerous because it is
  potentially more permanent. It can turn on any president who threatens its interests
  and survival.

I can go on and on, but you get the idea. Over sixty people have already made reservations to attend and another thirty have expressed interest through Facebook.
