

## TERRY CHERRY

A former middle/ high school teacher for 23 years Mr. Cherry, left the classroom December 2016. Cherry currently is living in Dallas, Texas area and has for the past 35 years. He has served as Educator Advisor for the 6th Floor Museum in Dallas, the Dallas Holocaust Museum and started the Educators Advisory Council of the Dallas Federal Reserve Bank.

At the local, state, and national level, Mr. Cherry has chaired various committees, and has been selected by members of his local council, the Texas Council for the Social Studies (TCSS) and National Council for the Social studies (NCSS) to represent them for different council offices, including president of all three.

In 2016 Cherry chaired the NCSS Executive Director Search Committee and Co-Chaired the NCSS Strategic Planning Committee. During this time, he also expanded the outreach of NCSS to various groups and organizations, seeking endorsements and partnerships by connecting social science associations to improve communication and relationships for stronger social science involvement in education.

In 2017, Terry representing NCSS has traveled to China with China Project Hope, to Korea with Korean War Legacy. He was part of the Transatlantic Outreach Program (TOPS) to go to Germany sponsored by GOETHE-INSTITUT. November 2018 and July 2019, he again traveled to China speaking to educators about teaching social science to Chinese educators using American style teaching methods. He traveled August 2019 to Athens, Greece speaking to educators from twelve European countries at the Korean War Legacy Foundation conference.

Terry has been indirectly and directly involved with Constituting America for six years. Currently he travels to middle and high schools teaching the Constitution to students and how to have a Civil Civic Conversation. He also speaks at various organizations about the importance of bringing back the teaching of the Constitution in our schools.
